MISCELLANEOUS:

1. Upon arrival a representative from each team will check in with the BYF and confirm its assigned Tournament Coordinator and individual team meeting area located in the upper portion of the parking lot adjacent to the field. Tournament Coordinators will be responsible for acting as a liaison between the team and the GSFL event scorers.

2. Parking will be available at the high-school in three primary areas: Area 1: on the basketball courts to the left as you enter off White Rock Hill road; Area 2: on the gravel parking area opposite Area 1; Area 3: in the parking lot between the school and the filed. (Parking along the entrance road is not permitted) As a reminder we encourage all to car pool to avoid a longer walk to and from the game field.

3. Head Coaches should arrive in time to check their team in before attending the Mandatory Coaches meeting @ 9:30AM

4. Tailgating is not permitted on school grounds. The Concession stand located at the game field will be open throughout the day.

5. The awards ceremony will take place immediately following the championship game at the fifty yard line.

6. Tournament results will be posted throughout the day on the front of the press box.

7. Coaches are asked to inform their guests at the game of the days agenda and tournament requirements.

Pool Play Rules

All pool play 10 minute running clock (25 second play clock), clock will stop on injury, 1 timeout per team.

Each team must get at least one complete series on offense regardless of time remaining*. Highest seed gets option of offense or defense to start game. Ball starts on 40 and goes in.

Defensive stop** of any kind allows other team to start on offense on the 40.

*One offensive series is until the offense scores, commits a turnover or failure to covert on 4th down

**"Defensive stop" includes turnover on downs, fumble, or interception

TD = 6 Points 2 PT Conv = 2 Points Extra point = 1 Point Field Goal = 3 Points

SCORING for standings
