

August 29, 2011 Addendum

This is adopted as of today. If someone has a special circumstance they can send an email to the rules committee. Please email me or Rules Committee member for any clarification. **BOTTOM LINE:** League wants two separate teams where possible with numbers. Please send updated rosters to the Web Master as needed per this Addendum.

ADDITION ADOPTED TODAY

- A team can only use swing players if they have 32 or less players, and then a definition of a swing player is defined by the previously posted rules listed again below.

If a team moves a player up or down, it must be posted on the Website by Wednesday prior to the game and can be reviewed by the Rules Committee

A non approved swing kid who has been rostered for 2 or more Varsity games is ineligible for JV playoffs.

December 7, 2005 Minutes

JV Team: It will be the goal of the league for all involved to field a 7th grade team. For the first year teams agree a JV team will be allowed.

JV Being classified, as any 7th/8th grader not deemed a starter for the 8th grade team, unless there is a number issue.

February 4 2008 Minutes

Varsity playing JV – Numerous issues of starting Varsity playing JV. *See rule in handbook* –

- Idea – put forth on Rosters initial for rosters before Labor Day and every game.
- Idea – if you started in the Varsity game you cannot play in the JV unless 15 or less on roster. Use non-starters first – regardless of position – to meet the number of 15.

The final decision was choice 2 - if you started in the Varsity game you cannot play in the JV unless 15 or less on roster. Use non-starters first – regardless of position – to meet the number of 15.

What is to few players (roster size) to play –

- If a program has less than 26 players involved that team has the option of not fulfilling obligation of JV team. Again notify the Head Coach of the opposing team by Monday before the game.

July 21, 2010 Minutes

Addendum added on 9/30/10 per GSFL Rules Committee;

JV rosters are set as posted on the “Web Site”. Any changes, which involve a non-posted JV player playing in the JV game, must be approved by the opposing team prior to the game. Any violation of this rule will cause a forfeit of the JV game and also a forfeit of the Varsity game if the player in question played in the Varsity game as well.

Permanent changes to the JV list once the season starts must be Communicated and approved by the league board of directors and then posted on the Web Site.
